Building In Faith Campaign

Over the last year we have listened to our parishioners, city council, and neighbors and have modified the building plan accordingly. We now have a firm plan with a \$16 million budget and are on track to start construction in June of 2010. This plan meets codes and requirements and has received positive response from our parish leadership, admin council and pastoral council, our neighbors and the city.

Last week at Mass we announced the exciting news of a \$5 million challenge gift from John Kleinheinz Jr. John is the son of John and Jane Kleinheinz, OLL Parishioners, and John is an Alumnus of OLL School, class of 1976. In addition, a small group of parishioners have pledged an additional \$2.5 million for a total of \$7.5 million raised. I am delighted to tell you that we are almost half way to our goal. We must meet the balance to receive John's gift.
