### The House came tumbling Down....

Last week the houses on the corner of Evergreen and the Alley were demolished to make room for the new play field. The site work is moving along steadily now with ground fill coming in by the truck full. The parking lot will start to take shape in the next few weeks. This week they will also begin work on sidewalks in and around the church and school.

### Phase Two

We must raise another \$2.9 million to break ground on the New Parish Center and School. We urge every parishioner to consider a pledge. A pledge allows us to secure "bridge financing" from the Parish Funds Trust for the project. Terms of your pledge are up to you; 2 year, 5 year, 10 year; monthly, annual, or deferred payments; check credit card or EFT. If you have already made a pledge, please consider stretching it one more year.

## Construction Update:



### Stay Alert!!

Thank you for your patience. Construction will keep us short of good parking in the next several weeks, as sidewalks are torn up in order to meet scheduled improvements. We will have signs to guide you to available parking or to redirect you around sidewalk construction. Parishioners with special needs may park in the front church drive if necessary.



### Weeks of 8/2 and 8/9:

- 8th Street sidewalk replacement - sidewalk may be closed in places until 8/6.
- Parking on 8th Street - may be limited or closed during this time. Look for parking on A Avenue.
- 8th Church driveway - watch for signs for intermittent closures. Use alley access when necessary.
- South entrance to church/parish hall elevators - Handicapped parking only, vehicle access for handicapped parking from 8th Street, following signs. Other vehicles may use available parking behind the school and parish office, accessed from alley. Follow signs for footpath to south entrance. Best choice is street parking.

### Upcoming Work (starting mid-August):

- A Avenue sidewalk replacement (south side of street) - sidewalk will be closed, look for parking on 8th Street and in the lot.
- Access to parking from 8th Street may be closed during the week for utility work.

### R E S P E C T L I F E C O R N E R

“The link between contraception and abortion is sometimes subtle and even insidious. This is true on the physiological level, where some contraceptives may prevent the implantation of a newly conceived embryo in the womb. This is especially a concern in the case of the ‘morning-after pill.’ But it is thought that other contraceptives, such as intrauterine devices and hormonal forms of contraception, may also act as abortifacients some of the time, not only as contraceptives. A woman using birth control pills does not even know if such an early abortion is occurring within her own body.”

**Why We Sing - Participation**

10. Holy Mother Church clearly affirms the role within worship of the entire liturgical assembly (bishop, priest, deacon, acolytes, ministers of the Word, music leaders, choir extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, and the congregation). Through grace, the liturgical assembly partakes in the life of the Blessed Trinity, which is itself a communion of love. In a perfect way, the Persons of the Trinity remain themselves even as they share all that they are. For our part, “we, though many, are one body in Christ and individually parts of one another.” (Romans 12:5-6) The Church urges all members of the liturgical assembly to receive this divine gift and to participate fully “depending on their orders [and] their role in the liturgical services.”

11. Within the gathered assembly, the role of the congregation is especially important. “The full and active participation by all the people is the aim to be considered before all else, for it is the primary and indispensable source from which the faithful are to derive the true Christian spirit.”
